Are you a survivor of domestic abuse, sexual assault, stalking, trafficking, or any other sexual offense?

Are you afraid of being found by your abuser?



Tennessee's Safe at Home Address Confidentiality Program can help to maintain the security of your home, work, or school address.

#### The ACP will:

- Provide you with a legal substitute address and securely forward your first-class mail to you.
- Help you access state and local agency services, like applying for a new driver's license, new car titles and tags, enrolling yourself or your children in school, or applying for SNAP or TennCare benefits, without revealing your physical address.
- Register you to vote without your voter registration being available to the public.
- Act as your legal agent for service of process, meaning that all court related documents are served to us and we will then securely forward the information to you.

## How to enroll:

 Meet in person with a Certified Application Assistant to help you complete the application process.

# Who should consider applying for the program?

Survivors of domestic abuse, sexual assault, stalking, trafficking, or any other sexual offense, who:

- Have recently relocated or who are looking to escape their abuser;
- Want to keep their location secret from their abuser;
- Are currently residing in a domestic violence shelter;
- Rely on, or will need to rely on, public assistance programs for themselves or their children.

## To be eligible for the ACP you must:

- Be an adult or a parent/guardian acting on behalf of a minor or minors; and
- Be able to provide documentation of your status as a victim in the form of court documentation, OR a permanent order of protection, OR a letter from a licensed professional attesting to the danger you are in; and
- Have moved to a new residential address (or a shelter) within the last 30 days, or intend to relocate to a new residential address in the next 90 days.
