

REQUESTING JAIL NOTIFICATIONS

As a victim, you have the right to be notified when a Defendant posts bond on your case and is released from incarceration. You can reach the Anderson County Detention Facility at (865) 457-7100. Defendants have a constitutional right to post bond for most charges, and if they are able to pay the bond amount, they will be released to await their court hearings.

You also have the option of obtaining offender release information from the Statewide Automated Victim Information and Notification System (SAVIN). SAVIN is a system created to keep crime victims, court personnel, law enforcement, and the general public informed concerning the custody status of offenders in the State of Tennessee.
